RE: Job Opening

There is a job opening that exists in the Trash department for an Equipment Operator II. If this position is not filled by a current employee within ten (10) working days, it will be open to the public on July 1, 2010.

DEFINITION

Under general supervision, is responsible for the operation of medium to large and complex equipment used in construction or ditching work of routine difficulty; performs related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS

Distinguished from Equipment Operator III class by the lesser degree of operating tolerance required by the operators of this class and the medium size, less complex equipment operated; and from the Equipment Operator I class by a higher level of difficulty and equipment complexity for this class. This position is filled by a person fully experienced in handling appropriate equipment, though some on the job training may occur in specialized cases.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Drives or operates equipment of a medium size including very large or heavy trucks such as a tractor-lowboy transport, large dump trucks, front-end loader, cherry picker, and backhoe; provides routine maintenance to vehicle or equipment; reports serious mechanical difficulties for repair; adjust equipment as needed in specialized operations; loads and unloads materials; performs physical labor as required; may lead in a crew to perform construction, maintenance and/or repair of drainage facilities may instruct Equipment Operator I's in various equipment operation and operate smaller equipment as necessary.

LICENSE

Must have CDL drivers license

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Skills, Knowledges, and Abilities

Skill in the operation of moderately complex construction equipment. Good knowledge of particular characteristics and working procedures for machines and equipment operated. Ability to

supervise a small crew in simple operations; understand and organize daily assignments of work to be accomplished.

Training and Experience

At least one year experience operating loader/knuckle boom in the trash department.
